This document, which was developed through the community engagement process, guided the District's work for the past six years. The Plan defined four focus (goal) areas. Strategies were developed for each of the focus areas and action plans were developed and implemented. It is timely for the Board, administration, staff and community to revisit the initial Strategic Plan, for the purpose of benchmarking accomplishments, determining current conditions of need and setting further direction for the District. Thus, administration has prepared a document which benchmarks meeting the expectations set forth in the Plan. This information was taken to the District Leadership Team in December 2006 and is now to be presented to the Board of Trustees.</p> <p>In addition, since the development of the initial Strategic Plan, many internal and external conditions have new influence on the direction of the District. These influences will be addressed throughout the meeting.</p> <p>Hence, it is timely for the Board to consider revisiting the Vision and Mission of the District in terms of deepening an internal and external understanding of the work of this District.
