The Board returned to Open Session at 12:38 p.m. A motion was made by Ms. Cranor and seconded by Mr. Rash that the Board approve and adopt the recommendation of the District Administration and do hereby expel **Student Docket No. 10-42** from attendance at the Pocatello/Chubbuck School District No. 25 for the first trimester of the 2010-2011 school year.

Such motion is based upon the judgment of the Board of Trustees that **Student Docket No. 10-42** has:

1. Engaged in conduct in violation of the District's policies with regard to the possession of a weapon on campus.
2. Engaged in conduct in violation of the District's policies with regard to the possession of tobacco on school property.
3. Engaged in conduct which demonstrates that the student's presence at school is continuously disruptive of the school's discipline and instructional effectiveness of the school.

However, pursuant to the statutory discretion provided to the Board relating to the discipline of students and with consideration of the input of the District's Administration, this expulsion shall be held in abeyance at this time and not put into effect contingent upon **Student Docket No. 10-42** meeting the following conditions:

1. **Student Docket 10-42** shall attend Crossroads for the first block of the 2010-2011 school year.
2. Such attendance shall be pursuant to a strict academic and behavioral contract, the terms of which are to be set at the sole discretion of the District's Administration. In order to establish this behavioral and academic contract, **Student Docket No. 10-42** and the parent/legal guardian of **Student Docket No. 10-42** shall attend a meeting at Crossroads with the School and District's Administration. This meeting must be scheduled prior to the commencement of the first block of the 2010-2011 school year and the purpose of this meeting will be to address the behavioral and academic expectations of the student.

4. Depending upon the success of **Student Docket No. 10-42** while at Crossroads and New Horizon **Student Docket No. 10-42** shall be considered for placement at one of the other District's High Schools.
5. **Student Docket No. 10-42** and the parent/legal guardian of **Student Docket No. 10-42** shall enter into all necessary and appropriate paperwork to allow for a free flow of information regarding any service or health care or counseling provider received by **Student Docket No. 10-42** solely relating to issues that will assist in providing educational opportunities to **Student Docket No. 10-42**.

Should **Student Docket No. 10-42** fail to meet the above stated conditions, violate any provision of the Behavioral and Academic Contract, or engage in any other infraction of District or School Discipline Policies, **Student Docket No. 10-42** shall be brought back before the Board of Trustees for consideration of implementation of the expulsion. 5. Attendance at Tendoy Elementary shall be pursuant to a strict academic and behavioral contract, the terms of which are to be set at the sole discretion of the District's Administration. In order to establish this behavioral and academic contract, **Student Docket No. 10-49** and the parent/legal guardian of **Student Docket No. 10-49** shall attend a meeting with the District's Administration.
6. Components of this Behavioral Contract shall include, at minimum:
  - **Student Docket No. 10-49** shall not be present upon school property in possession of any weapon.
  - **Student Docket No. 10-49** shall not engage in any discussion or conversation or drawings with peers regarding weapons or any type of violence while at school.
  - **Student Docket No. 10-49** will continue to work with the school's behavioral technician and counseling team.

Should **Student Docket No. 10-49** fail to meet the above stated conditions, violate any provision of the Behavioral and Academic Contract, or engage in any other infraction of District or School Discipline Policies, **Student Docket No. 10-49** shall be brought back before the Board of Trustees for consideration of implementation of the expulsion. The voting was unanimous in the affirmative. The Board recessed at 5:24 p.m.

1. **Student Docket No. 10-50** shall be placed on Homebound Instruction for the first trimester of the 2010-11 school year.
2. Prior to the conclusion of the first trimester, a meeting will be held between Administration, **Student Docket No. 10-50** and the parent/legal guardian of **Student Docket No. 10-50**. The purpose of this meeting will be to address a transition to Kinport for the remainder of the school year, the development of a continued behavioral and academic contract and a discussion of the behavioral and academic expectations of the student.
3. **Student Docket No. 10-50** and the parent/legal guardian of **Student Docket No. 10-50** shall provide the administration with appropriate and necessary documentation to provide for a free flow of information with any service or healthcare providers that would have information relevant solely to the issues of the student's education.

Should **Student Docket No. 10-50** fail to meet the above stated conditions, violate any provision of the Behavioral and Academic Contract, or engage in any other infraction of District or School Discipline Policies, **Student Docket No. 10-50** shall be brought back before the Board of Trustees for consideration of implementation of the expulsion. The voting was unanimous in the affirmative. The Board recessed at 6:18 p.m.

Prior to the commencement of the third trimester of the 2010-2011 school year, **Student Docket No. 10-51** and/or the parent/legal guardian of **Student Docket No. 10-51** shall be responsible for contacting and communicating with the District to schedule a Board reinstatement hearing to allow the Board to consider reinstatement for the third trimester of the 2010-2011 school year.

At such hearing the Board will determine if a return to the District is appropriate and if so, at what placement and under what reasonable terms and conditions re-enrollment would be allowed to occur.

As provided by Idaho Code 33-205, a Board of Trustees may establish reasonable conditions for a student's re-enrollment to a District. Accordingly, this reinstatement is conditioned upon the following:

1. **Student Docket No. 10-04** shall attend summer school during the summer of 2010.

- i. Attendance at summer school shall be through a strict Academic and Behavioral Contract, the terms of which shall be established during a meeting between **Student Docket No. 10-04**, the parent/legal guardian of **Student Docket No. 10-04** and the School's Administration.
- 2. **Student Docket No. 10-04** shall attend a placement hearing with the District's Director of Student Support Services. This placement hearing shall be held after summer school has been completed but prior to the commencement of the 2010-2011 school year. During such hearing, a determination will be made as to the proper placement for **Student Docket No. 10-04** for the 2010-2011 school year as well as appropriate terms for a behavioral and academic contract for the 2010-2011 school year. It will be the responsibility of **Student Docket No. 10-04** and/or the parent/legal guardian of **Student Docket No. 10-04** to schedule this meeting.
- 3. Appropriate documentation shall be entered into between **Student Docket No. 10-04**, the family of **Student Docket No. 10-04** and the District's Administration to provide for a free flow of information between the District and any agencies/private service providers working with **Student Docket No. 10-04**, relating to matters solely associated with and impacting upon education of **Student Docket No. 10-04**. Such information will be utilized only to assist the student in meeting his educational goals and to assist the service provider in meeting the provider's goals.

Should **Student Docket No. 10-04** fail to meet the above stated conditions, violate any provision of the Behavioral and Academic Contract, or engage in any other infraction of District or School Discipline Policies, **Student Docket No. 10-04** shall be brought back before the Board of Trustees for consideration of expulsion and revocation of the reinstatement to school. The voting was unanimous in the affirmative.
