**Call to Order/Executive Session – Student Reinstatement Hearing:**

Chair Gebhardt called the meeting to order at 4:41 p.m. A motion was made by Ms. Cranor and seconded by Mr. Murphy to adjourn to Executive Session. The roll call vote was unanimous in the affirmative: Ms. Cranor, aye; Mr. Murphy, aye; Mr. Facer, aye; Ms. Gebhardt, aye. The Board adjourned to Executive Session at 4:42 p.m.

**Purpose: To discuss student discipline.**

The Board proceeded to discuss student discipline as provided in Idaho Code, Section 67-2345 (1) (b) *to consider the evaluation, dismissal or disciplining of, or to hear complaints or charges brought against a public school student.*

**Return to Open Session:**

The Board returned to Open Session at 5:04 p.m. A motion was made by Mr. Murphy and seconded by Ms. Cranor that based on the information presented to the Board during the reinstatement hearing for **Student Docket No. 12-11** that the Board reinstate **Student Docket No. 12-11** to the Pocatello/Chubbuck School District #25 for the sixth block of the 2011-2012 school year.

As provided by Idaho Code 33-205, a Board of Trustees may establish reasonable conditions for permitting a student's return to school. This reinstatement is conditioned upon the following:

1. **Student Docket No. 12-11** shall be enrolled at New Horizon's High School commencing with the 6<sup>th</sup> block.
2. Attendance shall be pursuant to a strict Behavioral and Academic Contract, the terms of which shall be at the sole discretion of the school's administration, but shall require at minimum the following terms:
  - a. A minimum "C" grade average in all of his courses;

- b. Absent extreme medical emergencies, the student shall be present at school unless the consultation between the parent/guardian and the school's administration has occurred. The consultation may occur via telephone or in person at the discretion of the administration;
  - c. Credit recovery options will be addressed, including the possibility of summer school, at no cost to the District and with the existing contract in place.
3. Should **Student Docket No. 12-11** be provided any social services and/or health care services or be under the purview of the juvenile probation department, documentation will be entered into which permits a free flow of information between these individuals or providers and the school, only with regard to matters which impact upon the student's education.
4. Prior to the commencement of the 2012-2013 school year, the administration will hold a placement hearing to determine an appropriate placement with consideration of the activities during the sixth block and any attendance at summer school.

Should **Student Docket No. 12-11** fail to meet the above stated conditions or engage in any other infraction of District or School Discipline Policies, **Student Docket No. 12-11** may be brought back before the Board of Trustees for consideration of expulsion and revocation of the reinstatement to school. The voting was unanimous in the affirmative.

**Adjourn:**

A motion was made by Mr. Murphy and seconded by Mr. Facer to adjourn. The voting was unanimous in the affirmative. The Board adjourned at 5:06 p.m.
