The Idaho Governor's High School Athletic Plan for spectators, released on December 30, allows two spectators per student athlete at an event. The change allows high school athletes to each invite two spectators to their home and away games. Cheerleaders are allowed to invite two spectators to home games only. The spectators and hosting schools have to abide by strict guidelines. PCSD 25 requires that face coverings must be worn at all times. The Governor's order specifies that 12-feet of physical distancing is required from non-household members.
